

Coalition Corner: Take Five - Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Question: May I use published music or dialogue in my presentation?

Answer: CCTC supports the intellectual properties of our fellow artists and expects all materials to be licensed. Please note: It is our understanding that YouTube has been muting copyrighted materials even if the rights have been secured.

Question: What if I'm uncomfortable doing a presentation and I'm much more comfortable having a conversation?

Answer: No problem. We would happily match you up with a board member to record a conversation/interview with you.

Question: What if I want to participate, but I don't have an idea for a specific topic?

Answer: Let us know about your area of interest and we'll gladly discuss topics/themes with you.

Question: How long should the video be?

Answer: The target length for your content should be between 5 and 7 minutes total. We are hoping to present quick, bit-sized pieces of information that will inspire theatre artists to hone their craft, take a new approach, or enhance their abilities.

Question: Who is my audience? What should be the focus of my video presentation?

Answer: While these videos can be viewed by anybody, the intended audience is for participants in community theatre in the state of Colorado. This can vary from people in large metropolitan areas with multiple theatre companies to people in rural areas with one theatre company.
